Hiking the Appalachian Trail

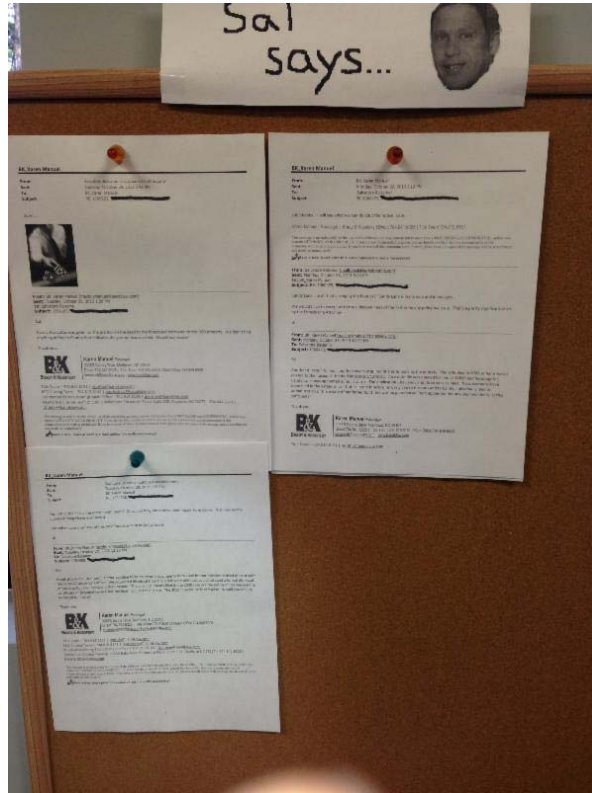
In our "After 5" articles we like to find interesting and
